Dear Delta Dental Participating Dental Office:

Effective July 1, 2009, Delta Dental of Iowa (Delta Dental) will be the sole dental benefits plan offered for enrollees of the *hawk-i* program. *hawk-i* is a state health care coverage for uninsured children of working families. *hawk-i* enrollees that currently have Blue Dental coverage will transition to Delta Dental coverage as of this date.

Please note the following:

- The effective date of this change is July 1, 2009.
- Due to the immediacy of this transition, *hawk-i* enrollees transitioning to Delta Dental may not have Delta Dental identification cards until mid July.
- To validate eligibility and benefits, please access the Dentist Connection on Delta Dental of Iowa's website at [www.deltadentalia.com](http://www.deltadentalia.com) or call Delta Dental at 800-544-0718.
- Services rendered on or after July 1, 2009 should be billed to Delta Dental.
- Benefits under the *hawk-i* plan have not changed and can be viewed on the Dentist Connection on Delta Dental's website at [www.deltadentalia.com](http://www.deltadentalia.com). There is no orthodontic coverage for *hawk-i* enrollees.
- To receive dental benefit coverage, *hawk-i* plan members must visit a participating Delta Dental network dentist. There is no coverage for services provided by a non-participating dentist.
