Multi-factor authentication required by Oct. 20

All Delta Dental provider accounts for the [Dentist Connection website](#) will require multifactor authentication (MFA) effective Monday, Oct. 20, 2025. MFA is required for each unique username even if you are using the same email address for multiple Delta Dental provider accounts.

If you have not already enrolled, we would encourage you to set up your MFA before Oct. 20. **If you are not enrolled by Oct. 20, you will not be able to access Delta Dental provider accounts until you set up your MFA.**

Orthodontia changes beginning Oct. 1

Beginning Oct. 1, 2025, Iowa Medicaid changed the criteria for orthodontia medical necessity from a Salzmann Score of 26 or higher to Automatic Qualifying Conditions for DWP, DWP Kids and Hawki. This applies for all D8080 comprehensive orthodontia services where Prior Authorization (PA) is submitted Oct. 1, 2025, or later. PAs submitted and approved prior to this date will be good for 24 months.

All PAs for orthodontia services **require** a completed the Orthodontic Medical Necessity form. Groundbreaking news for Iowa's dental workforce

DMACC recently broke ground on a new 26,000-square-foot Dental Building on its Ankeny Campus. The new facility will greatly expand DMACC's current dental space and increase enrollment capacity by 25 percent, while preserving small class sizes and student-instructor ratios. The building will feature advanced simulation labs, modern

classrooms, a public clinic, and student spaces designed to meet Iowa's urgent need for skilled dental professionals.

Support from partners such as the Delta Dental of Iowa Foundation, which made a \$250,000 investment earlier this year, has been instrumental in making the project a reality.
