CDT 2019 is Effective January 1, 2019

The new version of the Code on Dental Procedures and Nomenclature (CDT Code) is effective for services provided on or after January 1, 2019. The 2019 version includes 15 new codes, seven revised codes, four deleted codes and other minor edits. Overall, there are not significant code changes in 2019, but please ensure that claims are submitted with the most current codes.

CDT 2019 Highlights

- Three new codes for occlusal guards will be effective in January. These three codes include additional specificity to the type of material being used and replace the old D9940.
 - D9944 occlusal guard hard appliance, full arch (new code)
 - D9945 occlusal guard soft appliance, full arch (new code)
 - D9946 occlusal guard hard appliance, partial arch (new code)
 - D9940 (deleted)
- There were six additions that essentially create arch specific codes for space maintainers and unilateral partial dentures.
 - D1516 space maintainer fixed bilateral, maxillary (new code)
 - D1517 space maintainer fixed bilateral, mandibular (new code)
 - D1515 (deleted)
 - D1526 space maintainer removable bilateral, maxillary (new code)
 - D1527 space maintainer removable bilateral, mandibular (new code)
 - D1525 (deleted)
 - D5282 removable unilateral partial denture one-piece cast metal, maxillary (new code)
 - D5283 removable unilateral partial denture one-piece cast metal, mandibular (new code)
 - **D5281** (deleted)
- The following are additional new codes to CDT in 2019:
 - D0412 blood glucose level test; in office using a glucose meter
 - D5876 add metal substructure to acrylic full denture (per arch)
 - D9130 temporomandibular joint dysfunction non-invasive physical therapies
 - D9613 infiltration of sustained release therapeutic drug single or multiple sites
 - D9961 duplicate/copy patient's record
 - D9990 certified translation or sign language services per visit

The CDT codes have been designated as the national standard for reporting dental services under HIPAA and all offices that transmit health information electronically must use the current version CDT. Please be sure to use the most current codes.

The Delta Dental of Iowa Dental Office Manual will include all of the CDT updates along with processing polices and will be available on the Dentist Connection no later than January 1, 2019.
