Denture and Partial Denture Procedures

Effective February 1, 2020 Delta Dental increased fees for all denture and partial denture codes. We made this change to address the continued increase of lab fees that providers are experiencing. (codes: D5110, D5120, D5130, D5140, D5211, D5212, D5213, D5214, D5225, D5226)

We hope that this increase will allow providers to continue to provide these services to DWP members.

Electronic Billing

On February 1, 2020 dentists are required to submit claims for ALL Medicaid members electronically. This includes claims submitted to Delta Dental of Iowa, Iowa Medicaid, and Managed Care of North America (MCNA). Iowa Medicaid (IME) released an information letter in November and January concerning this change. Refer to information letters NO. 2090-MC-FFS-D, 2045-FFS-D, and 2022 MC-FFS-D.

IME implemented this requirement for the dental benefit administrators for the following reasons:

- Eliminates paper claims and attachments
- Reduces administrative burden

• Decreased processing time for claims – providers will be reimbursed faster

High Risk Caries Assessment

Hawki plan members, who are at "high risk" for caries are eligible for additional fluoride and bitewings radiograph benefits.

For the member to receive these additional benefits, the dentist needs to complete the Caries Risk Assessment Tool that can be found on the <u>Delta Dental</u> <u>Dentist Connection</u> website under Resources and then Forms.

Once the form has been completed, send it to Delta Dental. This forms needs to be completed annually for Hawki members to continue to receive additional benefits.
