



Delta Dental to manage children's dental benefits for Medicaid

The Iowa Department of Human Services (DHS) and Iowa Medicaid Enterprise (IME) recently announced children's dental benefits for Medicaid will be managed by Delta Dental and another dental benefits administrator starting July 1, 2021. The IME Information Letter (IL) can be found here.

As stated in the IL, children in Iowa will continue to receive a comprehensive dental benefit, with no annual benefit maximum. This benefit will also continue to provide medically necessary orthodontia. Delta Dental will begin recruiting providers for the Children's Medicaid network. More information can be found here.

Please note, the Hawki benefit will remain the same and there will be no changes.

CDT Changes

A number of CDT changes will be effective January 1, 2021. The changes include the implementation of 28 new procedure codes and the deletion of 4 codes. The

four deleted codes are being replaced by twelve new procedure codes.

The deleted codes and their replacement codes are:

- D3427 (periradicular surgery without apicoectomy) has been deleted and will be replaced by D3471, D3472, D3473, D3501, D3502, and D3503
 - o D3471, D3472, and D3473: surgical repair of root resorption anterior, premolar, and molar, respectively
 - o D3501, D3502, and D3503: surgical exposure of root surface without apicoectomy or repair of root resorption anterior, premolar, and molar, respectively
- D7960 (frenulectomy) will be replaced by D7961 and D7962
 - o D7961: buccal/labial frenectomy (frenulectomy)
 - o D7962: lingual frenectomy (frenulectomy)
- D0604 and D0605 have been created for antigen and antibody testing for the coronavirus; currently they are not covered benefits.
