




Expanding access

System and Capacity Building Grants

To further the mission of our partners, the Foundation approved grants to support system and capacity building to impact the oral and overall health of underserviced populations.

Nearly \$1.3 million was committed to the following projects in 2024:

\$30,000 mental health access expansion

Iowa Dental Foundation: \$150,000 to support Iowa Dental Advocacy for Professional and Personal Thriving (IADAPT), a mental health pilot program for Iowa dentists

Iowa Department of Health and Human Services: \$200,000 for I-Smile @School and \$212,988 for I-Smile Silver Pilot Project

NewBo City Market: \$75,000 to support Mental Health Equity Incubation Program



Delivering education & advocacy

Community of Health Grants

In 2024, the Foundation invested **more than \$710,000** in Community of Health grants to 27 organizations seeking to address oral and overall health disparities among individuals who are disproportionately impacted in our state. Some of these projects include a focus on:

ORAL HEALTH

- Dental workforce recruitment and retention
- Youth oral healthcare career development exploration
- Oral health in pregnancy and prenatal research
- Oral healthcare coordination and education for refugees and immigrants
- Integrated oral healthcare and mobile dental clinic coalition planning
- ✓ Veterans' oral health research

OVERALL HEALTH

- Community-led health initiatives to increase access to overall public health education, resources, services and care coordination for marginalized populations
- Mental health projects to expand awareness and access to training, education, resources and services for youth, domestic violence survivors, after-school providers, rural lowans, refugees and immigrants
- Projects to support advancement of culturally competent care through LGBTQ healthcare inclusivity training and training/ certification of Black and multicultural community health workers

Partnering for health

2024 Core Partnership Grants

Core Partnership grants support ongoing, operational or educational efforts and activities of organizations whose programs are in alignment with advancing the mission of the Foundation in strengthening the oral, vision and overall health of lowans. These grants are proactive and by invitation.

Oral Health Core Partnership Grants:

\$92,299 investments in six organizations focused on continuing education opportunities for the oral health profession and statewide oral health coalition support

Overall Health Core Partnership Grants:

Investments totaling \$137,165 in six organizations focused on vision health, statewide coalition efforts focused on mitigating Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACEs), and a statewide campaign to reduce stigma around mental health

RETHINK YOUR DRINK

To advance oral and overall health, the Foundation invested nearly \$300,000 in lowa schools and communities to support the Rethink Your Drink program in 2024 by providing water bottle filling stations to eight schools and three libraries. In addition, 23 communities received an outdoor water station installed along trails, public parks and other public community spaces.

Community Impact Contributions

Delta Dental proudly supports projects through direct investments and charitable giving to increase healthy activities, support healthy communities, and improve the social and emotional well-being of lowans. In 2024, Delta Dental contributed **\$954,688** to direct investments and charitable giving.





Improving lives with vision care

DeltaVision Free Vision Clinic

DeltaVision and the Delta Dental of Iowa Foundation, in partnership with OneSight EssilorLuxottica Foundation, Eastern Iowa Health Center and Prevent Blindness Iowa, offered free comprehensive eye exams to 507 Cedar Rapids-area adults and children, of which 438 were provided with free eyeglasses.

Nearly 90 volunteers including local ophthalmologists, optometrists, opticians and other skilled and general volunteers provided services at the event. This was the fourth year for the free vision clinic to be offered in Iowa and the second year it was held in Cedar Rapids, Iowa.
