More than 2,300 members donated \$140,000 with Delta Dental match to the Iowa Food Bank Association.

Bank Association and Delta Dental would double the donation.

COMMUNITY PARTNERS

An estimated \$1.5 million in COVID-19 relief to lowa non-profits, and community health centers focused on food insecurities, shelter and providing health and wellness services. In addition, funds were distributed to not-for-profit professional associations for recovery and relief efforts to lowa small businesses and their employees.

EMPLOYERS
