
Map of Oakridge Neighborhood





Helpful Tips When Registering:

- You will need to create an account through Onesight
- Once your account is created, login to complete your profile in its entirety in order to save your information
- Next you will need to click **Background Check Button** at bottom of MyProfile screen. User will receive an email from **Sterling Volunteers** that will take them through the process to submit a background check. If you are a licensed professional, you will need to upload a scanned copy of your license. Background check is processed in 1-2 business days (24-48 hours)
- Once background check is approved, you will receive an email to log back in and sign-up for your preferred volunteer shift(s). Please note if wanting to volunteer for a full day you will need to select a morning and afternoon shift for that day.
